

To reserve the best seating

To obtain the best seating possible, make your reservations early. The Lyric Theatre has a seating capacity of slightly less than 500. All of our seats are great, but some people have a special preference. See our seating chart below for options. Here's how it works:

We always give priority to the person who held a particular seat last season. Prior season ticket holders have until August 19, 2011 to renew their seats.

However, for both new and existing season ticket holders, we recommend that you call or mail in your reservation form with payment as soon as possible. We keep a list of all those who have expressed an interest in a particular seating area. Once previously reserved seats become available, we start at the top of the list and work our way down, giving priority on a first come, first served basis.

It's easy to purchase season tickets at Tupelo Community Theatre because we accept both MasterCard and Visa. Just call or come by the TCT box office and get on board for a great season of entertainment!

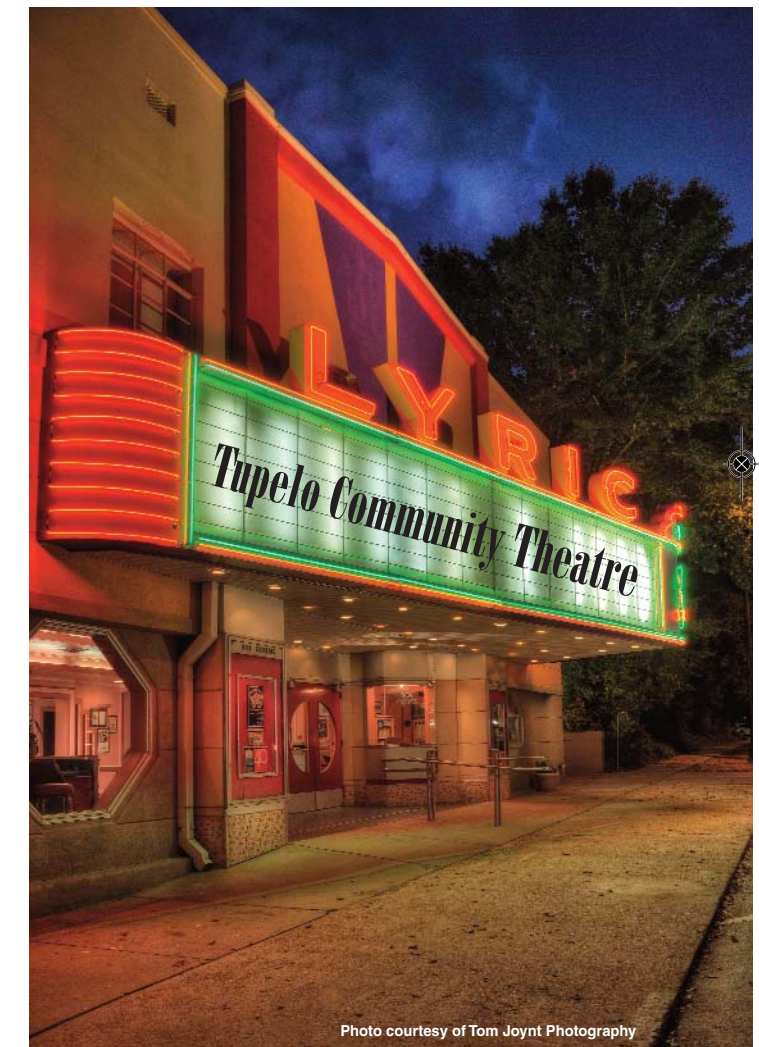
